Born and raised in Stuart, Fl. I attended Martin County High School, and graduated in 1991. In 1992 I joined the U.S. Navy, completing boot camp in San Diego, California. After boot camp I was stationed at Balboa Hospital in San Diego, California where I attended Naval School of Health Sciences. I remained in the military until September of 1996, and was stationed in several duty stations around the world.

Once I left the service I returned to Memphis, TN

(prior duty station) where I became a Security Supervisor for the Horseshoe Casino. One year later, I applied to the Memphis Police Academy, and entered the 76th Basic Recruit Class. After six months of the academy I was stationed at the North Precinct. During my 18 years spent with the Memphis Police Department I have worked Uniform Patrol, Street Crime Abatement Team, Organized Crime Unit, and Crime Scene Investigations.

I have held a National Registry as an Emergency Medical Technician, TN Post Certified Police Officer, and Graduate of the University of Tennessee Martin Instructor Development Course, TN Post Certified Police Academy Instructor, Crime Scene Instructor (latent impressions), DUI Officer, Mountain Bike, Crisis Intervention Officer, and Field Training Officer. I tendered my resignation, and left the Department in 2014 due to an unforeseen change in the retirement.

I applied and was hired by Palm Beach County Code Enforcement, and quickly established myself as a reliable officer within the County. I have, within a 2 year period, moved myself into a Supervisory roll with Palm Beach County Code. I currently have F.A.C.E. Fundamentals and Officer Safety certificates, and I manage a team of five code enforcement officers that concentrate on the central portion of Palm Beach County dealing with site plans, property maintenance codes, building violations, and Unified Land Development Codes.

I am the current Vice President for Code Enforcement Officers' Association of Palm Beach County (newly elected), and have a large passion for the Job. I am currently running for Sergeant-at-Arms.
